2025 ANPT ANNUAL CONFERENCE

The Academy of Neurologic Physical Therapy (ANPT) is excited to announce its' 2025 Annual Conference event to be held Thursday, October 16-18, 2025. The conference is being held at the Hilton Omaha in Downtown Omaha, Nebraska.

The ANPT annual conference aims to foster excellence in neurologic physical therapy by promoting

- knowledge translation strategies
- dissemination of clinically-relevant scientific evidence
- application of best practices, and
- networking opportunities among clinicians, scientists, educators, administrators, and students

We will do this by:

- examining recommendations and research evidence (for example, clinical practice guidelines, evidence-based documents, clinical trials)
- exploring examples of successful efforts of knowledge translation of evidence-based practices
- offering opportunities for meaningful engagement, discussion, and collaborationamong participants

The 2025 Academy of Neurologic Physical Therapy Annual Conference will carry forward the focus on promoting evidence-based practice, knowledge translation and person-centered care. The ANPT program committee invites education session submissions that support these annual conference aims. Educational proposals that encourage audience engagement, interaction and employ active learning strategies are encouraged. We welcome submissions of any topic relevant to neurologic physical therapy, including but not limited to:

- a. Original research
- b. Evidence-based documents and practices
 - i. Review of evidence on assessments, interventions, or diagnostic groups
 - ii. Clinical practice guidelines, meta-analyses, systematic reviews, EDGE documents
 - iii. Implementation of evidence-based practices
 - iv. Employing evidence-based practices in specific practice settings (e.g., acute care, inpatient rehabilitation, outpatient, home health, education, etc.)
- c. Integration of evidence and guidelines into education
- d. Perspectives from the patient and caregiver lens
- e. Shared decision-making research, frameworks, or application to practice
- f. Interdisciplinary team approach to neurorehabilitation
- g. Telerehabilitation, including assessment and treatment

h. Rehabilitation for patients with Covid-19, long Covid, and other Covid related sequelae

Additional Information:

- All submissions will be reviewed by the Annual Conference Review Committee and Planning Committee.
- ANPT plans to provide a select number of education sessions as pre-recorded, on-demand sessions after the conference. By submitting an education session, you agree to be approached for this opportunity by the Annual Conference Planning Committee. Pre-recorded sessions will be due September 12, 2025.
- ANPT encourages submissions to Annual Conference and CSM but kindly ask that the submissions not be identical. Submissions may describe a different research question or use a different analysis of the data.

<u>Interactive Education Session:</u> The ANPT Annual Conference promotes engagement across all education sessions. The addition of Interactive Education Sessions aims to encourage presenters to consider an alternate format to further support active learning.

The ANPT Annual Conference *Interactive Education Session* will be delivered using learner centered teaching strategies to encourage engagement, interaction and collaboration amongst attendees and presenter(s). Interactive Education Sessions will encourage active learning and participant engagement. Presenters will support active learning through the integration, application and exploration of evidence based best practice. This innovative learning experience may include implementation of the following strategies (including but not limited to):
