Registration FAQs

Who can attend:

The ANPT Annual Conference?

There are sessions appropriate for PTs and PTAs at all levels in their careers.
Open to ANPT members and non-members

International Conference for Vestibular Rehabilitation

This is an advanced conference and is appropriate for physical therapists, occupational therapists, vestibular basic scientists, audiologists, and physicians. It is not appropriate for entry-level students.

What is included with the attendee registration?

Registration at the [ANPT Annual Conference](#) includes access to:

- all education sessions October 13-15
- handouts from presenters who provide them
- evening poster receptions with light appetizers and cash bar October 13-15
- exhibit hall during open hours
- breakfast October 14 and October 15

How do I cancel my registration?

ANPT is offering risk free registration through Thursday, September 1, 2022. Cancellation requests for the ANPT Annual Conference and/or International Conference for Vestibular Rehabilitation registration received by September 1, 2022, will receive a full refund with no penalty fees. After September 1, no refunds will be offered. Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to info@neuropt.org. Refunds cannot be provided for no-shows.

Programming & CEU FAQs

How many CEUs can I earn and how are they awarded?

Attendance at **ANPT Annual Conference** may be worth up to 1.1 CEUs (11 contact hours/CCUs). To earn CEUs/contact hours/CCUs, participants must successfully pass a posttest with a score of 70% or better. The number of CEUs/contact hours/CCUs for each educational session, as well as assessments and downloadable certificate, will be available starting October 14. The post-test assessments and certificate downloads **must be completed by November 30, 2022**. [Review state-specific information here.](#) Learn more about the CEUs [on this page](#).

Attendance at ANPT **International Conference for Vestibular Rehabilitation** may be worth up to 1.0 CEUs (10 contact hours/CCUs). To earn CEUs/contact hours/CCUs, participants must pass a learning assessment with a score of 70% or better. The number of CEUs/contact hours/CCUs for each educational session, as well as assessments and downloadable certificates, will be available starting October 16th. How will my licensing board know which sessions I attended?

ANPT courses are accepted in many states as a component of the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA). Your Conference certificate will list all sessions you attended based on completing (and passing) the session posttest. You can access the listing of all your sessions by selecting the Posttest/CEU Certificates from the left-hand navigation. **All tests & evaluation must be complete and downloaded by the time the conference access ends November 30, 2022, 11:59 PM ET.**

How will I get my CEU certificate?

Your certificate will be provided through the website and can be accessed by the Posttest/CEU certificate link. You must complete all posttests for sessions attended *and the event evaluation* prior to accessing your certificate.

How do I access posttests?

On the conference website in the left navigation, click on CEU Information or from the home page click on the Evaluation/Posttests/CEU button to be directed to the posttest site. It is on the honor system that you attended a session you are taking a post test.

What is the deadline to receive my certificate?

November 30, 2022, 11:59 pm ET the conference platform will close. Attendees must complete posttests and conference evaluation prior to this date.

How many times can I retake a posttest?

Unlimited tries at test retakes.

What is the passing requirement for posttests?

70% of answers must be correct to successfully pass the posttest.

Do I have to complete the session posttest in one sitting or can I come back to it?

You can come back to any unfinished tests.

Website FAQs

What do I need to do to access the website?

On or after September 1, 2022 a link will be sent to the email you registered with giving you access to the conference website. Each attendee should log into the site and set up a profile following the prompts provided. This allows for online networking prior to, during and after the conference. Additionally, this is where the CEU/Contact Hour information is stored.

Where can I access conference information?

The education session overview, handouts and presenter information, posters, exhibitors, and program for each conference can be found [on the conference website](#) until November 20, 2022.

Registration for each conference is open until October 9, 2022 through [the web page](#).

What time zone will the live events be listed?

The conference is occurring in Minneapolis, Minnesota which is Central Time. The times on the website will display based on the time zone set up in each user's profile. The online programs for each conference will list the presentation in Central Time.

How can I connect with other attendees?

Networking: No CEUs given for networking sessions

Each evening an in-person Poster Reception will be held concurrently with exhibitors in the Exhibit Hall. This is a great time to visit with vendors and other attendees.

Virtually:

When you log in to the Cadmium website, you will be asked to set up a profile. This can be basic or detailed, public or private. For those who opt to make them public, other attendees will be able to connect with you through the platform with questions or ideas.

Conference Venue Layout FAQs

What does the physical layout of the conference look like? Are there different events in different locations?

All of the conference activities will be in one central location within the Hyatt Regency Minneapolis, with all rooms within a 2-3 minute walk of each other. The Exhibit Hall is the hub for many activities. The time for each activity is listed in the conference program.

Each morning, breakfast will be served for registered conference attendees and vendors in the exhibit hall. [Annual Conference Exhibit Hall](#) [ICVR Exhibit Hall](#)

Vendors will be in their booths during designated times during the conference. If you arrange an appointment with a vendor outside of those times, they will meet you at the entrance of the exhibit hall and escort you to their booth.

Each evening a Poster Reception will be held concurrently with exhibitors in the Exhibit Hall. Light appetizers and a cash bar will be available. Interact with poster presenters, participate in fun networking games, and visit with the vendors.
