
# Stroke Corner Podcast: Sleep and Stroke Recovery

Did you know that the APTA has a <u>Patient Action Center</u> where they can access resources to help with PT advocacy?

The damaging payment cuts and flawed PTA differential system being proposed in the 2022 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule are about **patient access**. If the rule is adopted as proposed, beneficiaries can anticipate reduced access to needed care, just as communities struggle with recovery from the effects of a pandemic.

APTA also offers an online flyer that includes a QR code to make the process of sending comments to the U.S. Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services as simple as possible: **Just print out the flyer**, post copies where you think they'll be noticed, and encourage everyone to grab the QR code with their phones and follow the simple instructions from there.
